AREAS OF EXPERTISE

- ❖ **Diseases of the Endocrine System** - disorders of the internal (endocrine) glands such as the thyroid glands and adrenal glands. Dr Rickard can assess disorders such as diabetes, metabolic and nutritional disorders and obesity.
- ❖ **Cardiac Disease** – diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the heart and blood vessels including abnormal heartbeat rhythms, hypertension and high blood pressure, ischaemic heart disease and heart failure.
- ❖ **Infectious Diseases** – diagnosis and treatment of bacterial infections, viral infections, fungal infections and tropical diseases, including malaria, HIV and tuberculosis.
- ❖ **Diseases of the Nervous System** - diagnosis and treatment of all types of disease or impaired function of the brain, spinal cord, nerves, muscles and autonomic nervous system. Dr Rickard has a special interest in dementia.
- ❖ **Disease of the Gastrointestinal System** - diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the digestive organs including the oesophagus, stomach, bowels, colon, small intestine, liver and gall bladder. Dr Rickard can assess conditions such as abdominal pain, ulcers, diarrhoea, cancer and jaundice.
- ❖ **Respiratory Medicine** – diagnosis and treatment of cancer, pneumonia, pleurisy, asthma, occupational and environmental diseases, bronchitis, sleep disorders and emphysema. Dr Rickard can assess complex disorders of the lungs and respiratory system including pulmonary disorders in the immunocompromised host, and pulmonary manifestations of systemic disease.
- ❖ **Kidney Disease** – diagnosis and treatment of disorders including fluid and mineral imbalance.
